

INSTALLATION

Before installation, make sure the OpenCart Extension Installer is correctly configured, especially for the FTP settings, including the FTP Root. See

<<http://docs.opencart.com/extension/installer/>> for more details.

1. Unzip the product_pdf.zip.
2. Go to “Extensions”->“Extension Installer”:



3. Upload the file product_pdf.ocmod.zip
4. Go to “Extensions”->“Modifications”. You should see an entry for this – “Upload Pdf for OpenCart 2.x/3.x”:





8. Click on “Get License” button. Enter License Key –This key is provided when you purchase the extension.






1. For upload Pdf go to Catalog->Products->PDF tab, add or edit product for upload pdf.



2. Upload the required pdf using "Browse" button:




3. After uploading pdf, click on “Save” button:
